The Morsani College of Medicine (MCOM) of the University of South Florida (USF) is conducting a national search for a distinguished academic leader to serve as the Director of Functional Magnetic Resonance Imaging (fMRI).

The University of South Florida is developing a leading-edge fMRI research and imaging facility slated to open in Fall 2024. The facility will feature a GE SIGNA Premier XT 3.0T MR System. The Director will join the USF MCOM and enhance specialized diagnostic and research imaging for USF, Tampa General Hospital, and TGH Imaging. This position offers a unique opportunity for a dynamic leader to shape the future of functional imaging and make significant contributions to the field of medical imaging research and practice.

The successful candidate will lead significant programmatic growth in imaging and translational research, with the additional aim of expanding research opportunities for the functional MRI program. Further, the Director will build upon existing opportunities to advance complex, high-end functional imaging and research to align with institutional initiatives and capitalize on the opportunity for programmatic growth.

The Director will be responsible for standing up the comprehensive fMRI Imaging Center, leading its strategic growth, and expanding the overall functional imaging research program. Additionally, they will grow the portfolio of sponsored research for functional imaging research and ensure the excellence of research and training programs. This position will be instrumental in shaping the future of USF's fMRI program, leveraging expertise to expand research collaboration and drive cutting-edge imaging discoveries. This position presents an opportunity for a visionary leader to enhance the stature of MCOM's institution both nationally and internationally while playing a key role in promoting collaborations across the greater USF system.

The ideal candidate will have a national reputation in fMRI research with established, nationally-recognized, and competitively funded research programs (including projects with NIH and/or other federal funding) and additional expertise in graduate/medical student education and mentoring. Start-up resources are available for candidates with NIH or other grant funding, and this position will include faculty appointment and/or leadership positions within the department(s) befitting the candidate's background and experience. The Director will also have matrixed reporting to senior leadership at the Morsani College of Medicine. Requirements include a Doctoral degree from an accredited institution or the highest degree appropriate in the field of specialization with a demonstrated record of achievement, in teaching, academic research, and service.
